Mayor Cooner called the meeting to order and asked that all stand for the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a moment of silence.

Mayor Cooner welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Approval of Minutes

Councilman Charles Dukes motioned to approve the minutes and Councilwoman Benita Gibbs seconded the motion.

No Public Comments

Mayor Pro Tem Glenn Miller was concerned about the Tornado Relief money.
Mayor Tim Cooner said that Council needs to decide what to do with the money.

Councilman Chris Ott motioned to approve the Financial Report and Councilman Charles Dukes seconded.

Mayor Tim Cooner stated that Kevin Pendarvis had resigned as of November 3, 2008
Mayor Cooner then read his letter of resignation.

Mayor Pro Tem Miller stated that there needs to be a daily deposit made from the Water and Sewer Dept.

Mayor Tim Cooner discussed the Water Project on Calhoun and Hollyhock road.
He stated that the Project should be completed sometime in March.

Mayor Tim Cooner stated that the next Town Council Meeting will be held on December 8, 2008 due to the Christmas House Tour being held on the first Monday night in December.

Mayor Tim Cooner asked if all Council had received a letter from Mr. McCarns and asked if Council thought that it should be turned over to an Attorney.
Mayor Pro Tem Miller said yes it should be and all Council agreed.

There was discussion on the Towns Police Car issue.
Mayor Cooner said he went to the bank and the loan value on the car is 6600.00 and that we have had quite a few calls on the car. MASC said the we can put a minimum bid on the car.

Councilman Charles Dukes asked if we had put a dollar amount on the car yet.
Mayor Cooner said that we have an offer on the car at this time.
Mayor Pro Tem Miller suggested that the Town put the car up for sealed bid and that the minimum bid should be 6500.00. he also stated that he feels we would get that much for the car.
Councilwoman Amy Bryant suggested that we go ahead and SELL THE CAR.

Councilman Charles Dukes made the motion to go into Executive Session and Councilman Chris Ott seconded the motion.

After Executive Session

Mayor Tim Cooner called the meeting back to order.
He stated that on November the 4th 2008 the Town Clerk would start excepting all sealed bids on the Police Car. and that the deadline would be on November 10,2008.
Mayor Pro Tem Miller said that NO personal checks would be accepted. and that the minimum bid would have to be 5500.00.
Mayor Cooner said that Councilwoman Georgianna Harmon, Councilwoman Benita Gibbs and himself will meet on November 10,2008 to except the bids from the Town Clerk.

Councilman Charles Dukes motioned that the meeting be adjourned and Councilwoman Georgianna Harmon seconded.
