MAYOR COONER CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AND ASKED THAT ALL STAND FOR THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE FOLLOWED BY A MOMENT OF SILENCE

MAYOR COONER WELCOMED EVERYONE TO THE MEETING

MAYOR COONER ASKED THE PLEASURE OF COUNCIL ON APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES FOR MAY 4, 2009
MAYOR PRO TEM MILLER MADE THE MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES
COUNCILWOMAN HARMON SECONDED THE MOTION

TOMMY VICKERS BROUGHT BEFORE COUNCIL HIS DESIRE TO BECOME POLICE CHIEF

A CONCERNED CITIZEN ASKED WHEN HEALTHPLEX WOULD BE FINISHED, COUNCILWOMAN HARMON STATED THAT IT WAS NOT MOVING FAST ENOUGH

MAYOR COONER TOLD COUNCILWOMAN HARMON THAT SHE COULD BE IN CHARGE OF THAT PROJECT

COUNCILWOMAN HARMON QUESTIONED THE ORANGE FENCE THAT HAS BEEN PUT UP AT THE OLD TOWN HALL LOCATION SHE ASKED IF WE WERE GETTING READY TO BREAK GROUND FOR THE NEW TOWN HALL

MAYOR COONER SAID "NO MAM, SOME FINE CITIZEN TURNED US INTO DHEC FOR ASBESTOS AND NOW IT WILL COST THE TOWN SOMEWHERE AROUND 300,000.00 FOR CLEAN UP"

COUNCILWOMAN HARMON ASKED WHEN THE TOWN WILL BE CHANGING OUT THE WATER METERS

MAYOR COONER SAID THAT IF THERE ARE ANY FUNDS LEFT OVER WE WILL CHANGE THEM OUT

COUNCILWOMAN HARMON QUESTIONED THE SALE OF THE RESCUE SQUAD BUILDING SHE SAID WE SHOULD HAVE AN ORDINANCE

COUNCILMAN CHRIS OTT MADE THE MOTION TO MOVE ON TO THE COMMITTEE AND STAFF REPORTS

COUNCILWOMAN HARMON SECONDED THE MOTION

MAYOR COONER DISCUSSED 911 ADDRESSING, AND THE TOWNS SIDEWALKS

COUNCILMAN CHARLES DUKES MADE THE MOTION TO ADJOURN FOR EXECUTIVE SESSION


MAYOR COONER MADE THE MOTION TO ADJOURN
