MAYOR COONER ASKED THE PLEASURE OF COUNCIL TO APPROVE THE MINUTES  
COUNCILWOMAN AMY BRYANT MADE THE MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES  
COUNCILWOMAN GEORGIANNA HARMON SECONDED THE MOTION

MAYOR COONER STATED THAT HE IS TRYING TO PUSH FOR A NEW SPORTS COMPLEX WITH IN THE TOWN LIMITS, AND THAT IT COULD POSSIBLY BE A 2 MILLION DOLLAR PROJECT

MAYOR PRO TEM GLENN MILLER STATED THAT HE FEELS A MEMBER OF COUNCIL SHOULD BE ON THE BOARD OF ANY ORGANIZATION THAT IS RECEIVING FUNDS FROM THE TOWN

MR. MILLER ALSO SAID THAT HE HAS RECEIVED SOME CALLS ABOUT HIGH WATER BILLS AND MAYOR COONER REPLIED THAT ALL RADIO READ METERS SHOULD BE IN PLACE BY THE END OF SUMMER AND THAT ALL ADJUSTMENTS WILL BE IN WRITTEN FORM FROM NOW ON

MAYOR PRO TEM MILLER ASKED ABOUT THE CHLORINE PROBLEM THAT WE HAD LAST SUMMER

MAYOR COONER SAID THAT IS FINE NOW AND SUGGESTED THAT ALL PEOPLE THAT SIGNED THE AGREEMENT FOR THE NEW WATER SERVICE SHOULD PAY A FLAT RATE EVERY MONTH IF THEY HAVE NOT PAID THEIR TAP FEE AND HOOKED UP TO THE WATER. IT STATES IN THE WATER AGREEMENT THAT THEY WILL BE FINED \$1000.00

MAYOR COONER ALSO SAID THAT THE TOWN MAY OWE THE RESCUE SQUAD 22000.00 INSURANCE MONEY FROM THE TORNADO DUE TO A LETTER GEORGIANNA HARMON PRESENTED TO THEM
