There was discussion about the 22,000.00 being paid to the Rescue Squad from Insurance Proceeds, Mayor Pro Tem Miller stated that he was not in favor of insuring

Mayor Pro Tem Miller motioned that all steps will be taken for the correct and complete Budget in our May meeting


Councilwoman Harmon seconded the motion
