COUNCIL MINUTES

APRIL 2, 2012

PRESIDING: MAYOR TIMOTHY COONER

Mayor Pro Tem Glenn Miller called the meeting to order and said that Mayor Cooner was not feeling well and would not be attending the meeting tonight

Mayor Pro Tem Miller then asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance and a word of Prayer

Mayor Pro Tem Miller then asked the pleasure of Council for the Approval of the Minutes

Mayor Pro Tem Miller said the windows are in place now at the new Town Hall and they have started the roof and everything seems to be running smoothly

Mayor Pro Tem Miller then turned the meeting over to Councilwoman Amy Bryant for Branchville Youth Sports She stated that the Town has outgrown Horton Field and they are having to turn children away she then turned the meeting over to Mr. Michael Blankenship, he said that there will be a Jamboree at Horton Field this coming weekend and had estimated @ 2000 people would be attending

He went on to discuss with Council the need for a new Sports Complex and wanted to know why there has not been anymore discussion on this project since last year

Mayor Pro Tem Miller stated that it is out of our control that the Town has not received our money from the County

Mayor Pro Tem Miller said that he hope the Jamboree is a big success this weekend

Councilman Robert Berry asked Mr. Blankenship if a piece of property has been found for the Complex

Mr. Blankenship replied that at one time there were a couple pieces of property that were being considered

Mr. Blankenship stated that Branchville Youth Sports had paid to have the trees cut down and that they have put a lot of money into Horton Field

Mayor Pro Tem Miller said he would see if the Mayor would be willing to contact Harry Wimberly again and see what the update is and that he appreciates what all they have done with the kids and the Town

Councilwoman Amy Bryant stated that she has been searching for Gym floors for the Old Lockett Gym Project

Mayor Pro Tem Miller then thanked everyone for coming out tonight

Councilwoman Amy Bryant made the motion to Adjourn
